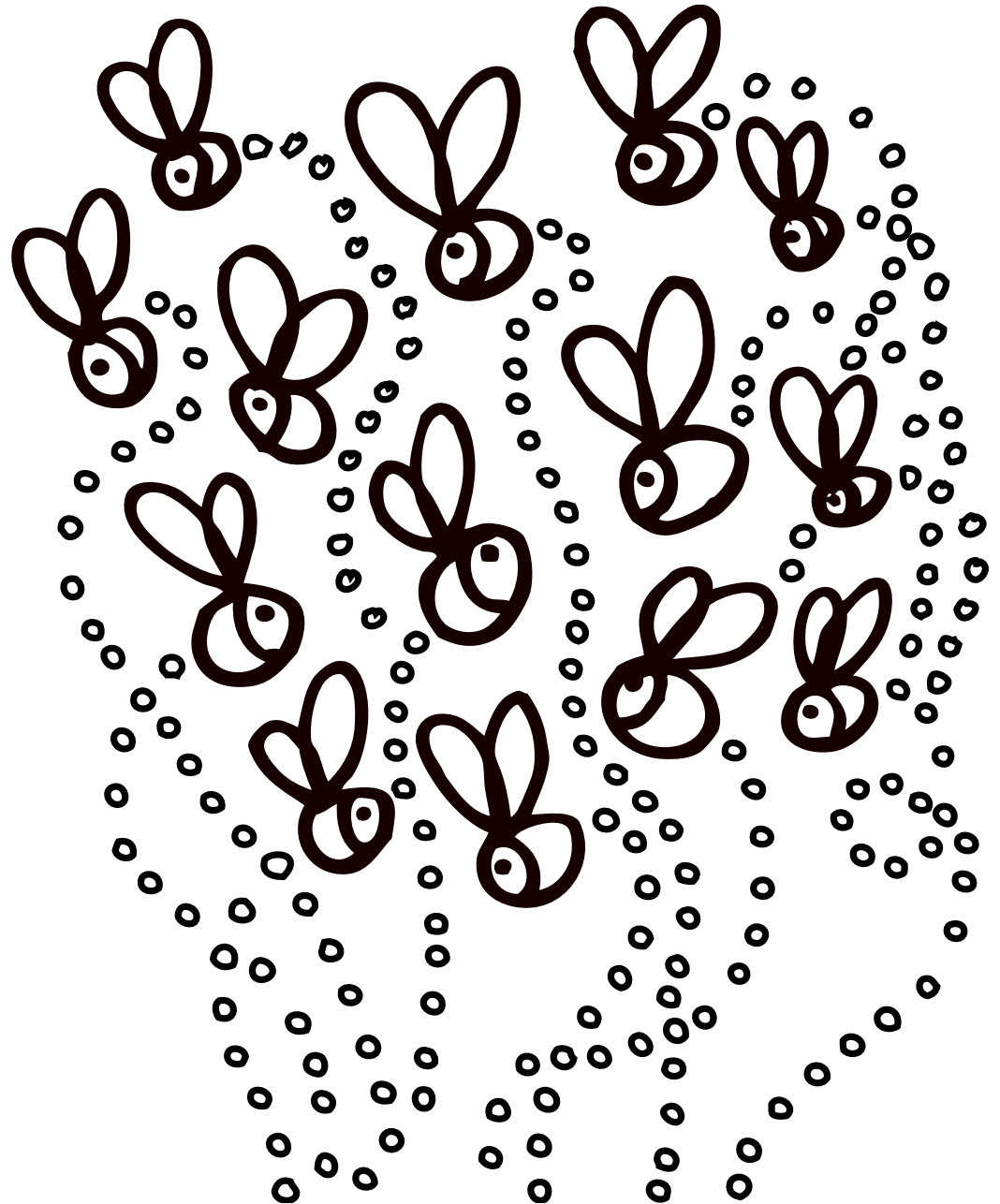
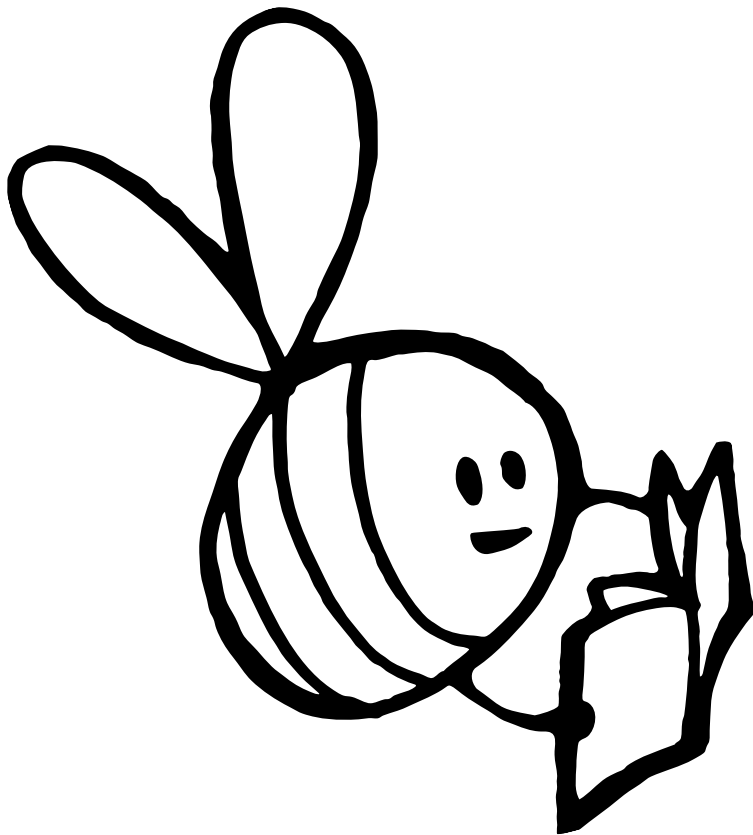


Financial Stability

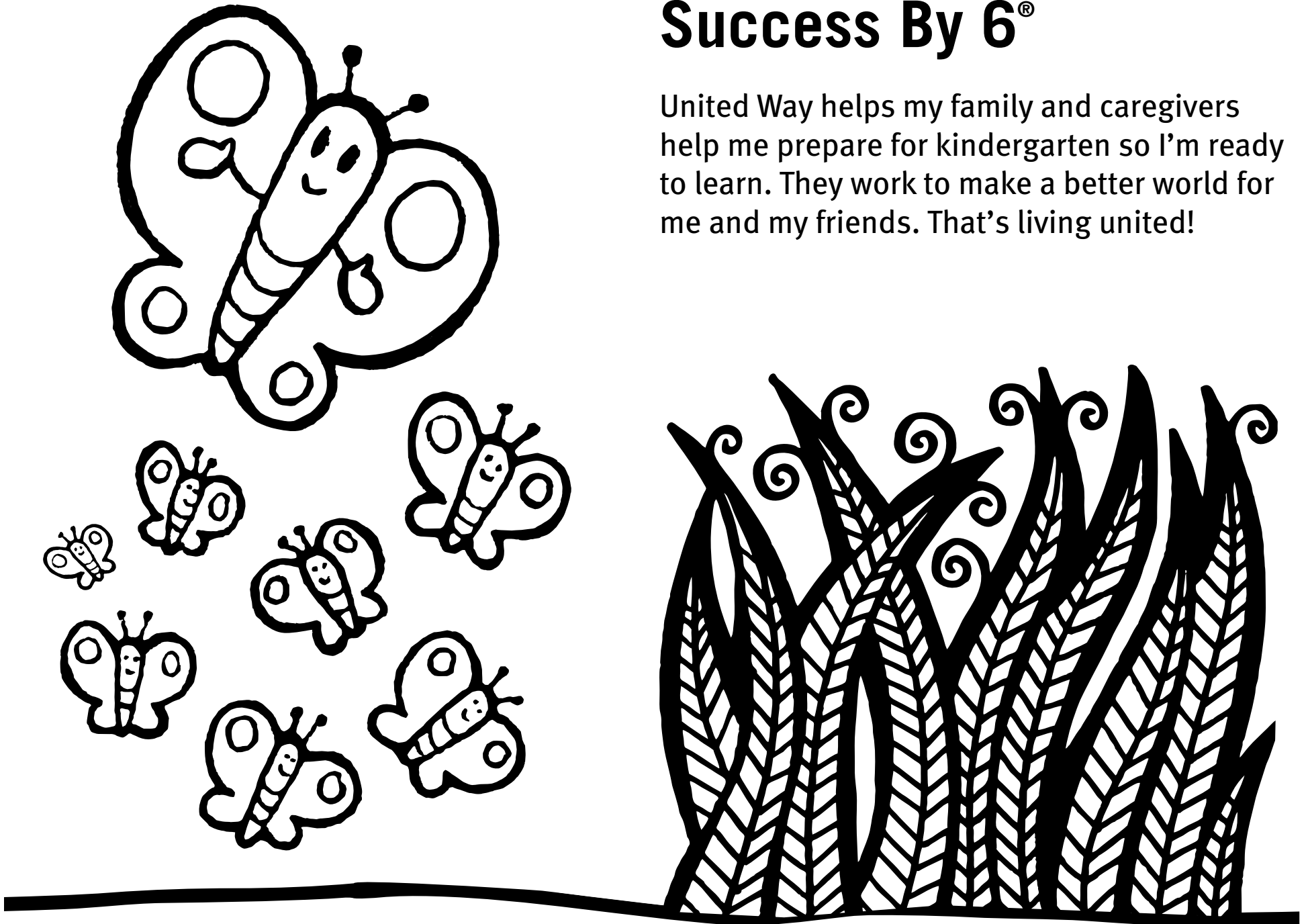
The Volunteer Center

United Way brings people to my school to read, play and learn with us. Volunteers help other people. I can help, too. When I help someone else, I am living united.



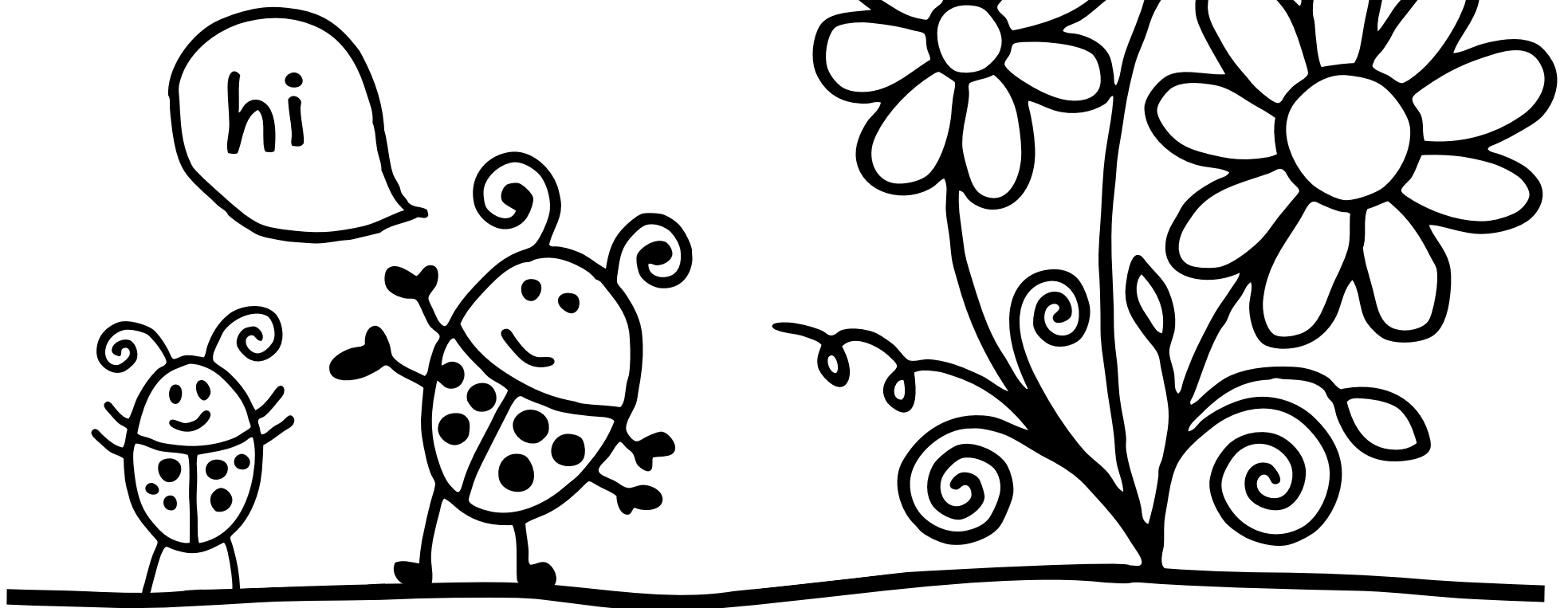

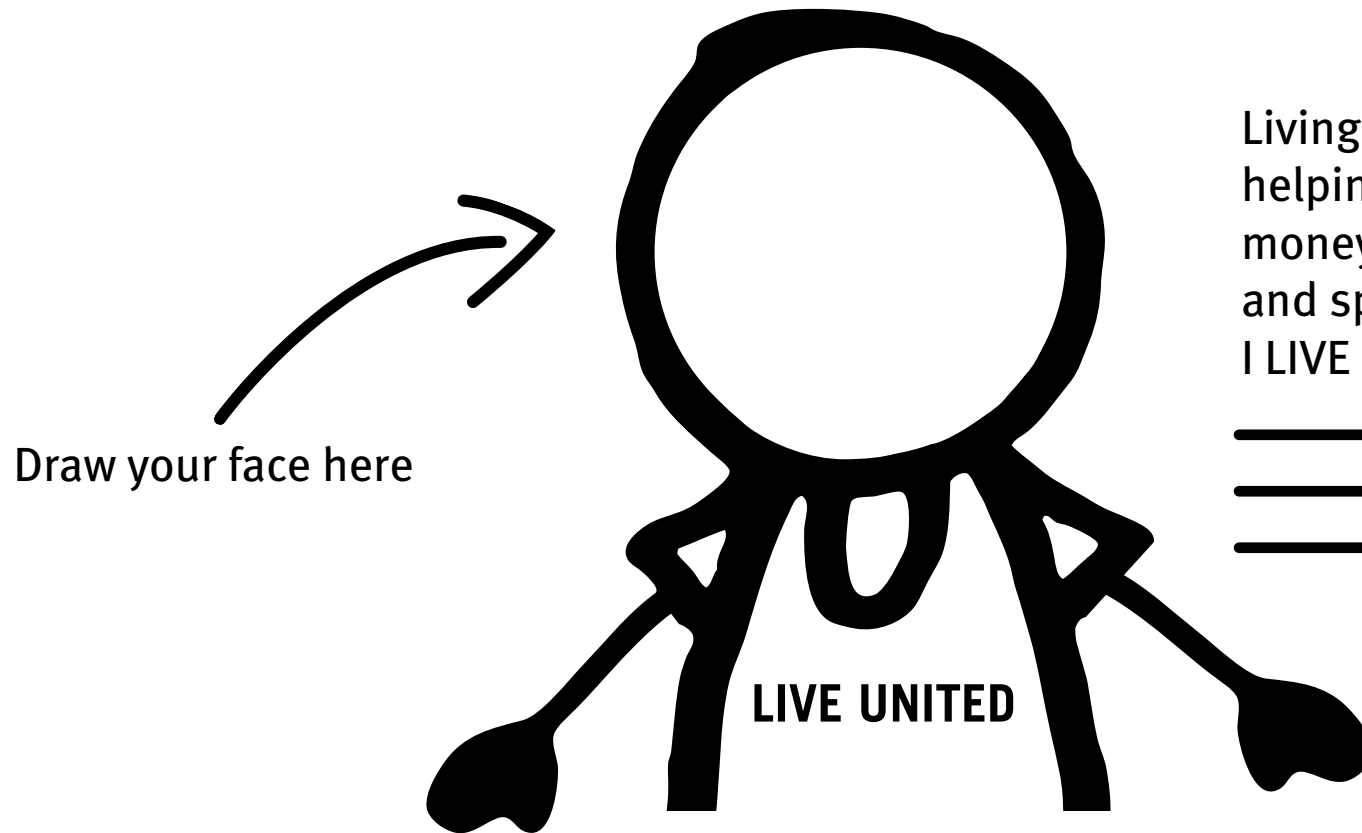
