COMMUNITY SERVICE & IMPACTS

United Way of Snohomish County (UWSC) drives **equitable, community-led solutions** that address systemic barriers and create positive, lasting change for **children and families** struggling to meet their basic needs.

For over 85 years, United Way has championed collaborative programs in Snohomish County like **Dolly Parton's Imagination Library**, **Varsity Letter in Community Service**, and **Best Dental Help**. In 2024-25:

- **137,040 free books** were mailed to **12,000+ local children**, sparking a love of reading and nurturing relationships between parents/caregivers and children
- **Varsity Letter in Community Service** program was relaunched to recognize local high school students who dedicate 145+ hours to volunteering
- Critical **oral health education** and **dental services** were delivered to **4,000 elementary school students**

United Way of Snohomish County is also a **trusted grant maker** selected by Federal and State departments to **allocate funds locally through public initiatives** like the Emergency Food & Shelter Program and the **Community Reinvestment Project (CRP)**.

As United Way looks ahead to needs and opportunities in 2026 and beyond, we envision an equitable Snohomish County where **every person—regardless of race, place or ability—has access to opportunity, stability, and the resources needed to thrive.**

Together with donors, volunteers, and community collaborators, we're **building stronger foundations** for children and families across our region.
